Position Overview:

The Cutting Department Lead is responsible for directing and motivating a team of Cutting Machine Operators, as well as operating and maintaining cutting machines to produce high-quality, accurate products. The ideal Cutting Department Lead will have a strong understanding of cutting processes and equipment, as well as experience in training and mentoring others.

Essential Duties and Qualifications:

- Set up and operate cutting machines (Rosenthal, Polar, and Kolbus) to cut various types of vinyl and cover materials.
- Review work orders and job specifications to determine components, settings, and adjustments for cutting machines.
- Adhere to cutting instruction manuals to produce accurate and consistent results, updating when necessary.
- Examine and inspect materials both before and after the cutting processes to ensure quality and accuracy.
- Perform routine and preventative machine maintenance including troubleshooting.
- Manage and submit department inventory levels of both raw materials and WIP goods to purchasing agent.
- Collaborate with various project teams for product development and testing.
- Ensure the department work area is clean and organized, while complying with all safety procedures and regulations.
- Train and mentor other members of the cutting department.
- Respond to daily needs of various departments and other project-based requests as needed.

Education & Relevant Experience:

- High school diploma or equivalent required.
- 3+ years of experience operating cutting machines preferred.
- Ability to read and follow complex cutting instructions.
- Ability to set up, operate, and maintain cutting machines safely and efficiently.
- Strong attention to detail and accuracy.
- Ability to communicate updates to team members effectively.
- Capacity to work independently and alongside a team.
